How to Get to the Conference and Tips for Accommodation

The venue of GLOBE Student Conference 2024 is the **Jan Palach Grammar School in Mělník**. [Mělník](#) is a picturesque town at the confluence of the Elbe and Vltava rivers [about 30 kilometers north of Prague](#).

From Prague you can reach Mělník **by train** from [the main train station](#) or you can **take a bus** from [metro station Ládví](#).

Transportation from the Airport to Prague center

Buses operate between Václav Havel Airport and Prague center. You can choose to travel by:

Airport express bus line

Direct line from the Airport to Prague Main train station (Hlavní nádraží in Czech). The bus runs every full and half hour ([timetable](#)) from a stop at Terminal 1. Bus tickets can be purchased in the Visitor Centre in the Arrival Hall or directly from the driver. The price of a one-way ticket is: 100 CZK (about 4 EUR). See closer information [here](#).

Bus line 119

Prague public transport tickets are valid for this bus line. The bus operates between both terminals of Václav Havel airport and Nádraží Veveslavín stop. At Nádraží Veveslavín, you can change to metro line A (green) and get off at metro station Muzeum, which is in the city center (close to Venceslas Square).



Arrival to Prague by train

Most international trains stop at the Prague Main Train Station (Praha Hlavní nádraží). The station is located in the city center and has direct access to metro line C.

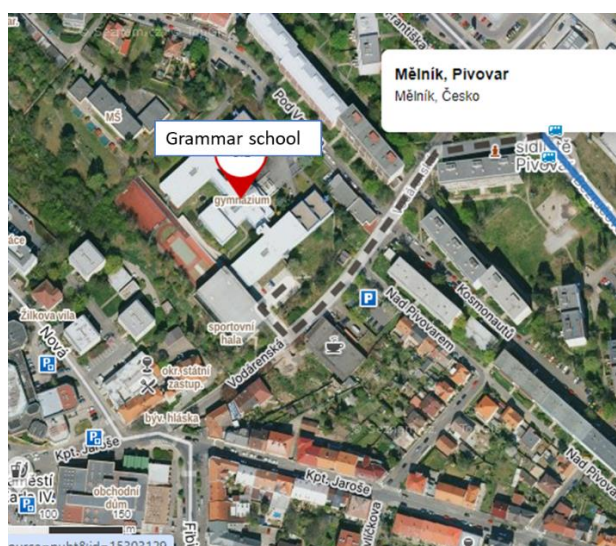
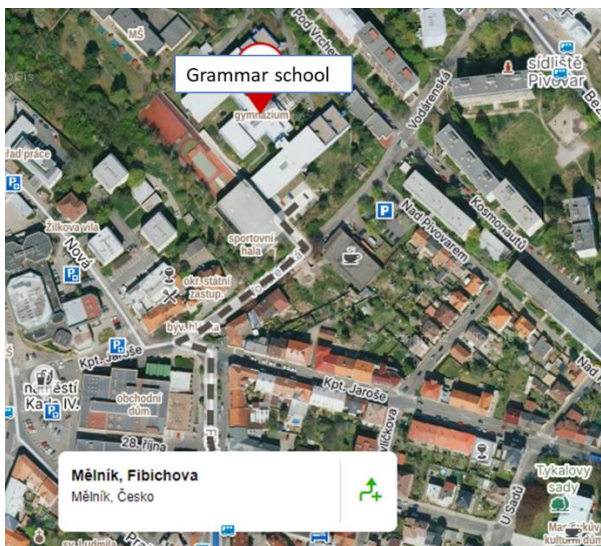
Transportation from Prague City center - the Main train station/metro line C stop “Muzeum” to Mělník

Both stops, Muzem and the Main Train station are on the line C (red). To travel to Ladvi, you need to get on a metro in direction to “Letňany” station.

At **Ládví** you can change to a bus to Mělník. There are two options:

- The bus line 369 to the station “Mělník Fibichova”
- The bus line 349 to the station “Mělník Pivovar”.

From both stations it is about 5 minutes walk to Mělník Grammar School. [Find timetables here](#).



Prague public transportation

Prague has a robust public transport network that includes metro, trams and buses. **Tickets for public transport** can be purchased at the information centers at the airport/metro, at ticket vending machines or from the bus driver and **must be validated** (by inserting them into a yellow box) when first entering a vehicle. On trams, tickets can also be purchased via a contactless terminal.
