Download the App

Find NASA GLOBE Observer on the **App Store** or **Google Play Store**. You will need email access to register for an account.

Collect Points

There are three ways to earn points by taking **Land Cover** observations with the GLOBE Observer app.

4 Points

Visit an **OBSERVATION STATION**. While taking your observation, be sure to capture the station in your **DOWN** photo.



2 Points

Take observations near **DESIGNATED POINTS** along the trail. View a map of these points: go.nps.gov/GO-on-a-Trail



1 Point

Take an observation **ANYWHERE** along the trail.

Share Your Observations

Remember to **submit your observations** in order to earn points. Participants who collect the most points will win a certificate and prize package.
